Seed Pass Challenge.

Put some seeds or frozen peas / corn in a bowl. Have another bowl next to it or to make the challenge harder a metre or 2 away. Using chopsticks pass the seeds from one bowl to the other. Time how long it takes and challenge each other for the best time!

Blind Flower Painting.

Put on a blindfold and try to draw or paint a picture of a flower. The best flower wins.

To Think about

- 1. Have you ever planted seeds or done any gardening? Did you enjoy it?
- 2. Jesus tells us that the seed that is planted in us is God's Word! The seed is the truth about God and Jesus. Can you remember or think of any truths you have learnt about God or Jesus? Which one is your favourite?
- 3. When the seed is planted in us who makes the fruit grow in us? (Find the answer in 1 Corinthians 3:6)

The Parable of the Sower




A farmer went out to sow seed. Matthew 13:3






"I'm a Doer" Flower Craft

James 1:22 says "But be doers of the word and not hearers only." God plants the seed in our hearts and the Holy Spirit waters it, when we do what the word says it's like we are feeding it with fertiliser. The more fertiliser it has the better the fruit will become.



This little activity will help you to remember to be "doers" of God's word, not just hearers.

- Print out the flower patterns onto card / paper, colour them in then cut them out.
- 2. Keep the petals together in a safe place, then whenever you do one of the things that is written on one of the petals, you can tape that petal onto the flower head. Try and do what is written on each petal this week to complete the flower.
