





Treasure Hunt.



Parable

The Mustard-Seed

Help the bird get to the top of the tree.



Jesus said that the Kingdom of Heaven was like a mustard seed. A mustard seed is the smallest of seeds, but when a man planted that seed in the ground it grew into a great tree. That mustard tree made a safe place for all the birds to come, rest and build nests. Let Jesus plant a seed of love in your heart which can grow and touch others.

Jesus told parables to teach people about the kingdom of God. He said the kingdom of God is like a mustard seed - it will start small and then grow!

PRETZEL Craft and Prayer Activity

Easy soft delicious Pretzels . . . remind us of the yeast parable and also of arms crossed in prayer. As you make them and enjoy eating them, why not pray that God's word will spread out across the earth so that everyone can know his love.

Ingredients:

water
instant yeast
milk
salt
sugar
flour



To make:

- 1. Combine yeast and water in a large mixing bowl. Add milk, salt, and sugar. Stir in the flour to make a stiff dough. Knead on a floured counter a few times. Let the dough rest for about 5 minutes.
- 2. Roll into ropes and form into pretzel shapes. Place on a lightly greased baking sheet. Brush with milk and sprinkle with salt if desired
- 3. Bake at 200°c / 400°f for about 15-18 minutes or until lightly browned.

Prayer Hands

Look at the fingers on one of your own hands, touch the "little one", the tallest, the index finger and the thumb. Use your fingers to talk to God.

- ▼ Fold your fingers down so only the little finger is pointing upwards. Talk to God about people who are young, small or weak.
- ▼ Hold up the "ring" finger. Talk to God about people we love.
- Hold up the tall "middle" finger. Ask God to help people who are in charge of things, such as those who make laws and those who keep us safe and well (like police, medical staff and so on).
- Hold up the index finger so it points the way to go, just as parents, carers, teachers and leaders help to point us in the right way.
- ♦ When you spread out your fingers, the thumb points away from the fingers. Pray for people who are in other countries, for mission partners and for those living in difficult circumstances.

^{*}For traditional pretzels, sprinkle them with coarse salt. Leave them plain or eat them with butter and jam.
